

Project Conservation of Marine Resources in Central America

Financing entity: German Cooperation, through KfW

Objective: to consolidate the selected coastal and marine protected areas in the region and secure the use of coastal and marine resources in the medium term

Phase I: Began in 2012 in 4 protected areas

Phase II: Began in 2015 in 5 protected areas

Duration: 5 years each phase

Amount granted: €5 millions each phase

Superior objective


To contribute wing maintenance of the ecological functions of the Mesoamerican Reef.

Project objective

To consolidate the Marine Protected Areas selected in the project region and secure use of marine and coastal resources in the medium term

Three components

- Conservation of coastal marine ecosystems.
- Improving management practices and sustainable use of coastal and marine resources.
- Implementation of mechanisms for the exchange of knowledge and experiences among the project's target groups and project development through small grants



Project indicators

- Superior Objective
 - Mangrove cover remains or bigger than baseline
 - Sea grass cover remains or bigger than baseline
- Project Objective
 - Financial gap does not increase in the areas
 - Management plans updated and under implementation in the areas
 - Areas have natural resources use plans

Activities indicators

- Component 1
 - At least 12 infraestructure initiatives under an adequatte use
 - All equipment purchased has regulations and usage records
 - Park rangers (MPS staff or community) receive at least two trainigs a year about management of natural resources
 - A control and surveillance plan exists and it is implemented
 - Four management plans under implementation
 - At the end of the project, the MPAs have improved their governance and socioeconomic indicators

Activities indicators

- Component 2
 - Community development strategy
 - All productive initiatives have a feasibility/market/business study, training mechanisms and technical follow-up
 - An increase in the number of community rangers trained, certified and involved in the protected area management
 - Mechanisms/process (community advisory committees) that guarantee the participation of local actors in the decission making regarding the management of the MPAs and that meet at least twice a year

Activities indicators

Component 3

- At least 9 small grants implemented and monitored
- At least two regional meetings developed and a follow-up process on the agreements
- At least four exchanges of experiences between the MPAs of the areas and/or others stakeholders
